VENUE and DATES

Dongo, CFVS club; June the 5th to 6th 2010

PROGRAM

8 races are scheduled for both Classes; first warning signal at 13:00 on the first day of regatta; the starting time of the first races of the following day will be posted by the Race Committee on the official notice board at CFVS before 7 pm of the previous day.

No more than 4 races will be sailed per day.

The event is classified Category C , according to RRS.

RULES

The regatta will be governed by the following rules:

ISAF RRS 2008-2012 with the integrations of the Italian Sailing Federation; this Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions
Any change and /or following notices will be posted on the Official Notice Board of CFVS

ADVERTISING

The event is classified Category C , according to the racing rule 79 and regulation 2D ISAF

ELIGIBILITY

While making the registration, it's necessary to show:

- 1- National Federation Association, valid for 2010
- 2- Class Association valid for 2010
- 3- Third part insurance of the boat of the minimum cover required by the Italian Sailing Federation(FIV) 1.000.000 €
- 4- No changes to sail numbers are allowed if not made after an official permission of the Race Committee.

ENTRIES

Entries shall be sent to the secretary of the CFVS by fax or email before June the 4th, and completed before 12 AM of June the first regatta day at the secretary of CFVS. Sailing Instructions will be available at the race office after 11AM of the first day.

The entry fees are (Regatta + BBQ)

49er: 60 €

MustoSkiff: 40 €

Each competitor shall have a valid third part insurance certificate

SCORING SYSTEM AND RESULTS

The Low Point Scoring System as described in RRS Appendix A will apply. When fewer than four races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

From four to eight races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

The series will be valid even with one only race sailed.

PRIZES

Prizes will be awarded to the top three boats of each class.
